REGULAR ACTIVITIES FOR 2017-2018

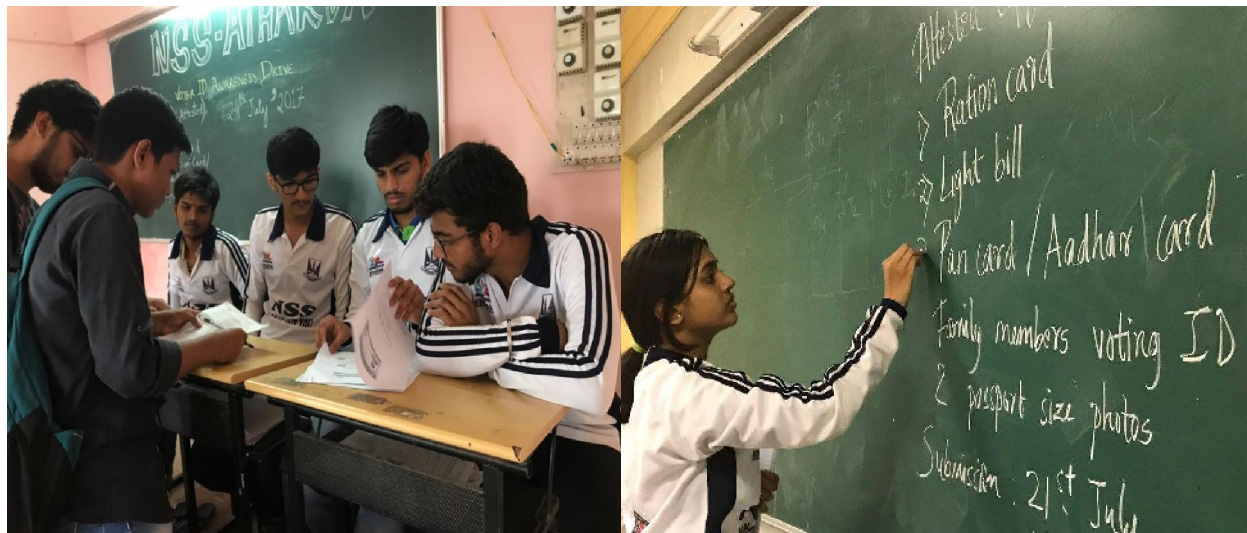
1. Port event: 14 July 2017

3. Oration event at Mumbai University: 17 July 2017

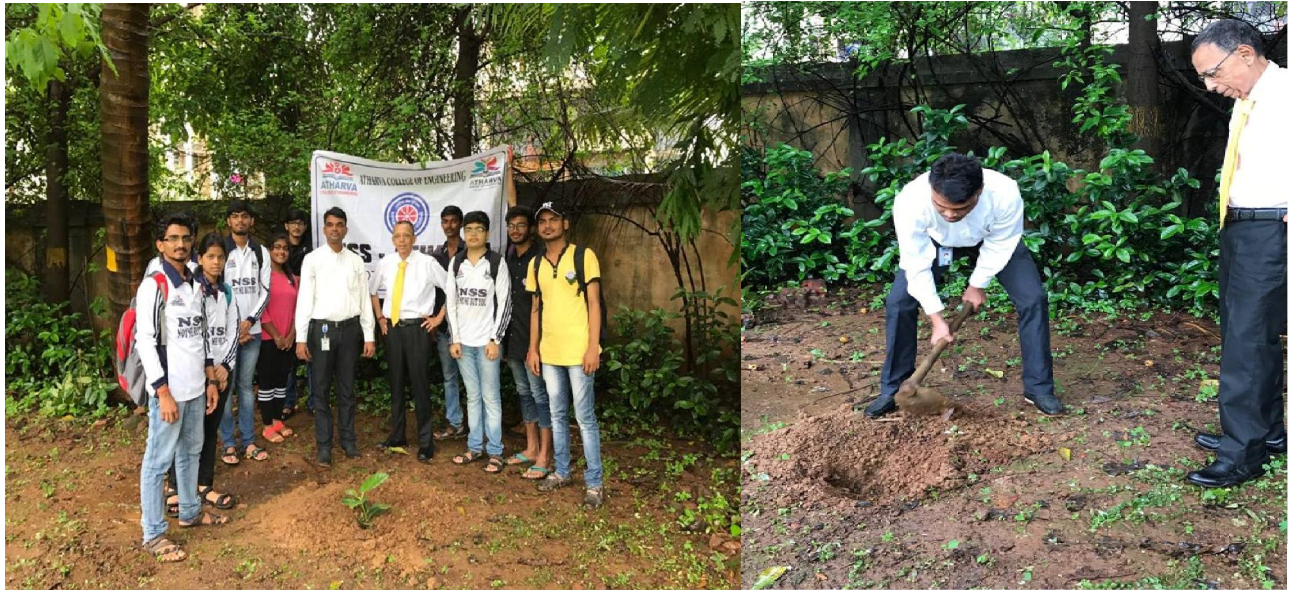

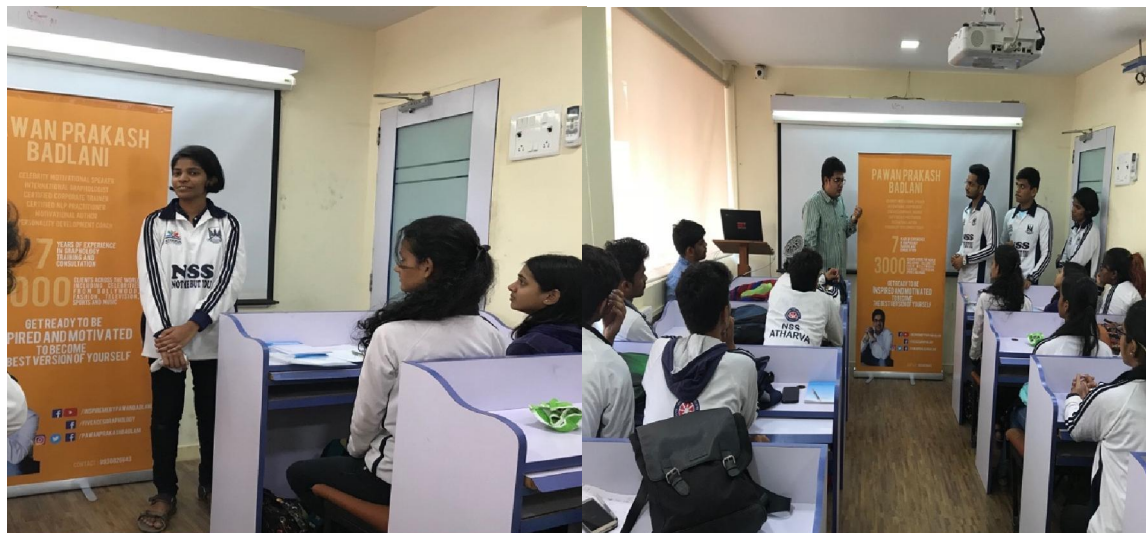
23. Motivation towards Indian Army: 6 October 2017
