
1. No Tobacco Day Pledge: 14th July, 2019

2. Big Mumbai Clean - Up drive: 21st July, 2019



4. World's Largest Lesson: 9th August 2019




5. Tree Plantation: 9th August, 2019

8. Deforestation Awareness Rally: 31st August, 2019


