


• NSS Orientation Program 2022-23 – 15th September, 2022

After this, Rajendra Nimborkar Sir came up on the stage and shared various experiences about his early army life. He completed his primary education from Satara Sainik School and later went to NDA. He served in the Indian army for 45 years. He was a part of the 15 Punjab Regiment and killed 22 terrorists as a general. The main sight of attraction was that Sir Rajendra Nimborkar was the 'Pramukh' in the Surgical Strike. He also said that about 82 terrorists were killed in the surgical strike with a loss of zero Indian soldiers.
