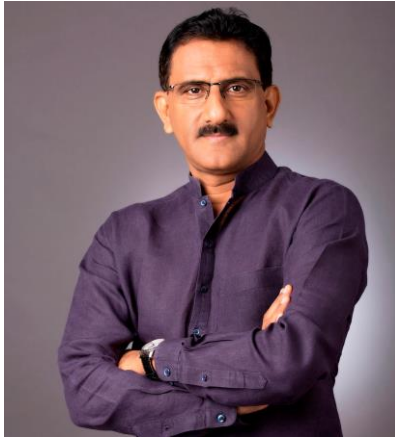

## Computer Engineering Department Activities:

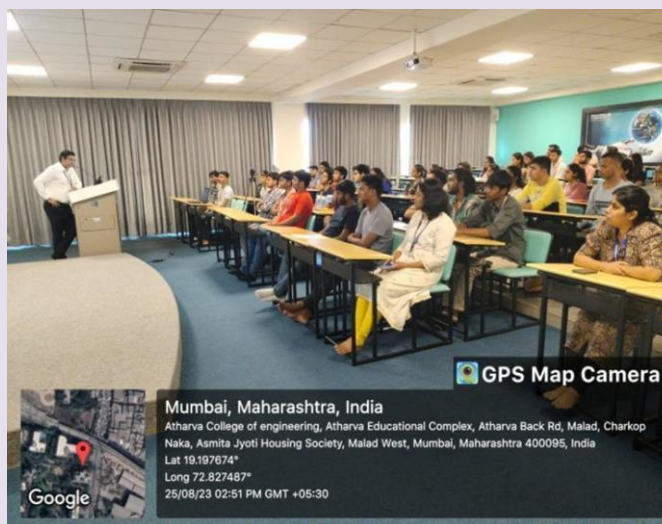
### Seminar on "Placement Preparation

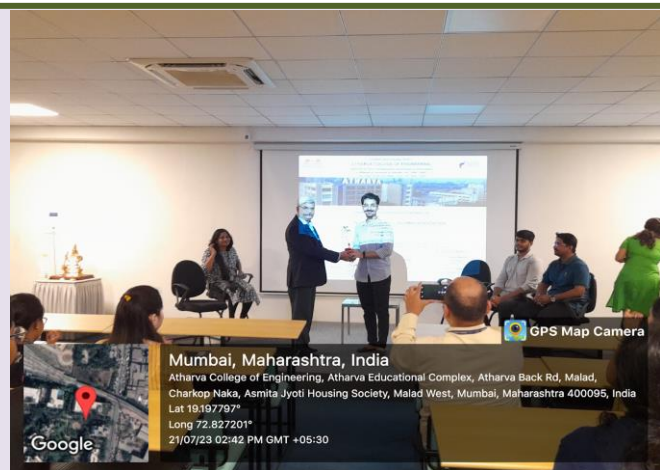
### Guest Lecture on “Computer Color Matching”

## EXTC Engineering Department Activities:

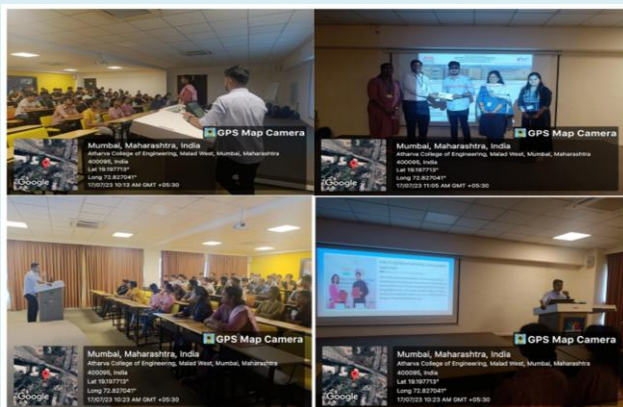

### Alumni Talk

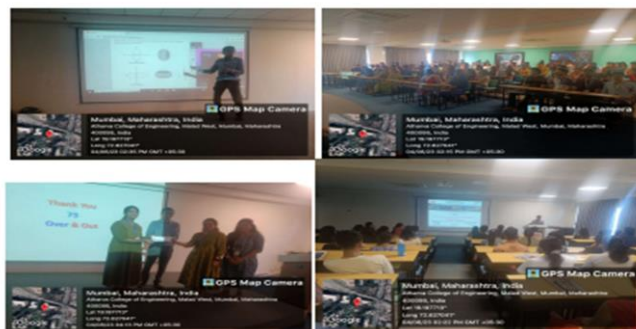

### **Tree Plantation for MMMD – 7th August 2023**

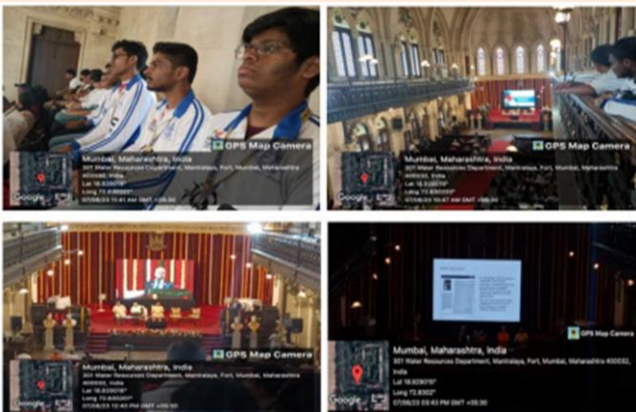
