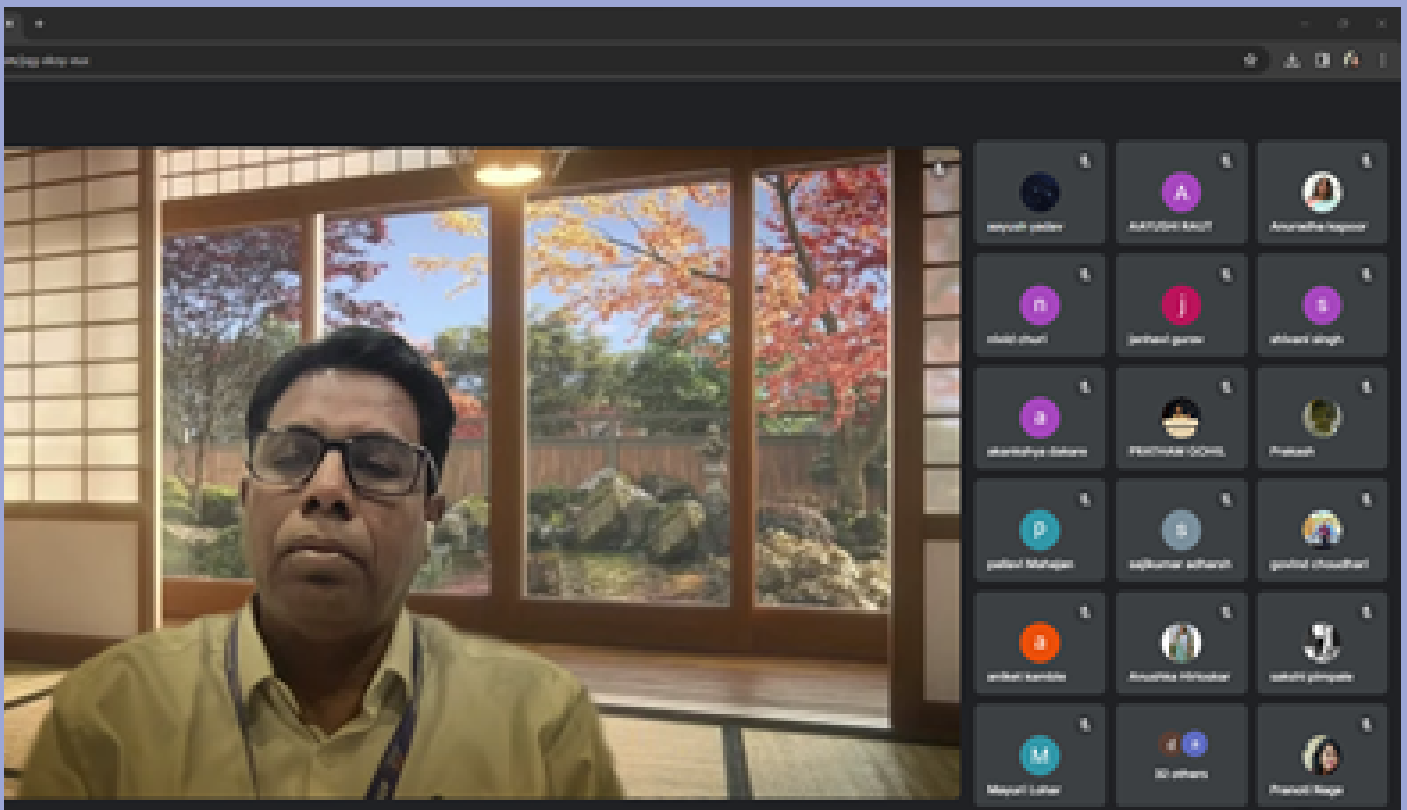
Around 147 parents attended the Parents - Teachers Meeting. One to One Interaction between Parents and Class Teachers, Faculty Handling Classes & Mentors.

Parents were informed about the placement process, support by college and career & higher studies guidance.

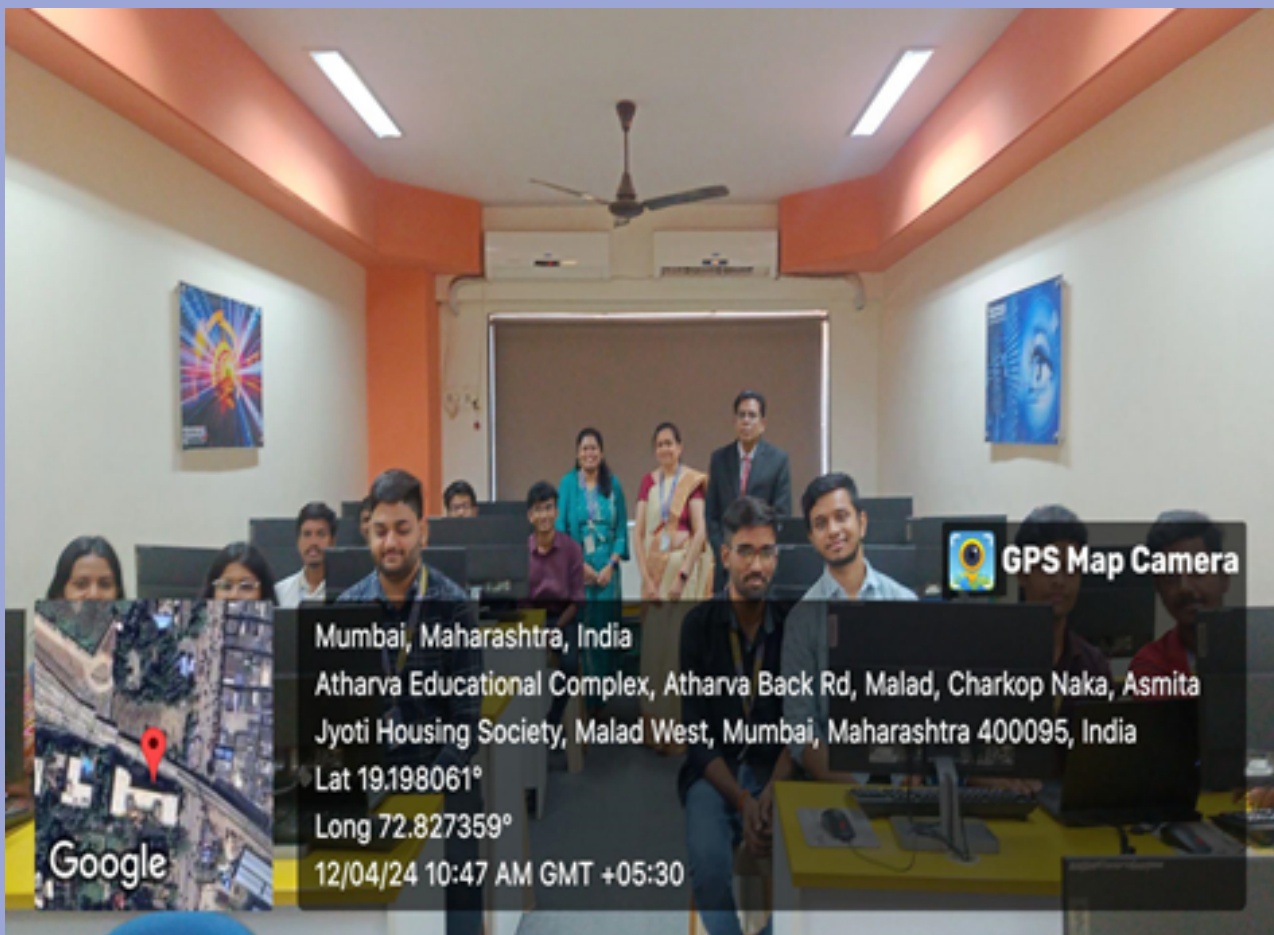
