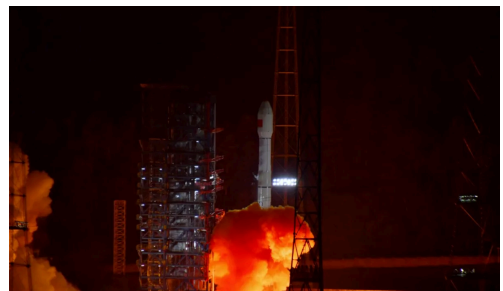

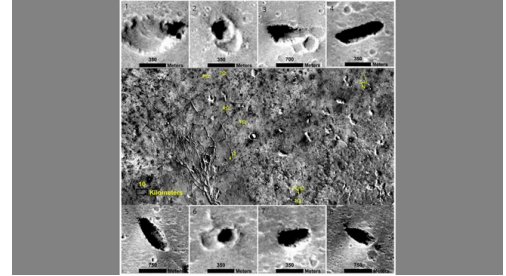

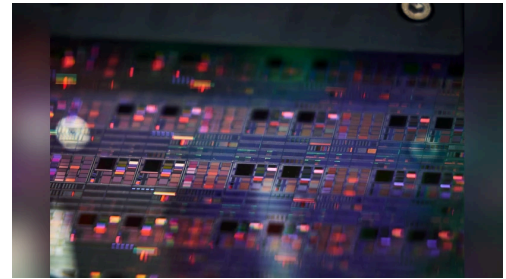


[AEIM to invest ₹10,000 cr in Raipur's semiconductor plant by 2030](#)

Semiconductor material and electronic components maker AEIM plans to invest Rs 10,000 crore in its Raipur-based facility by 2030, the company said on Monday.

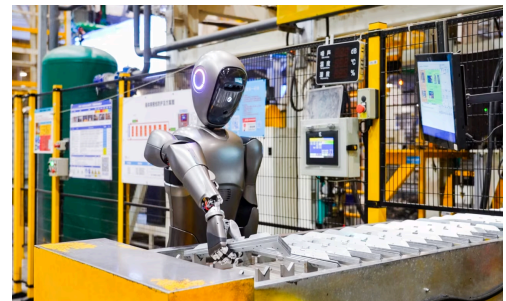
The company, in a regulatory filing, said it has been allotted 11.28
