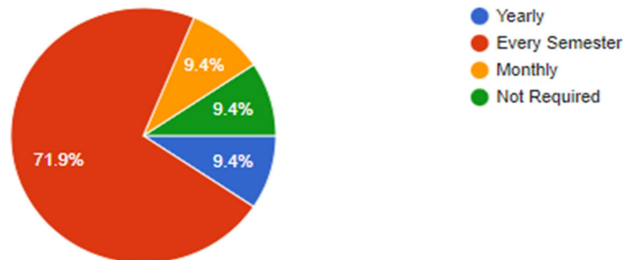

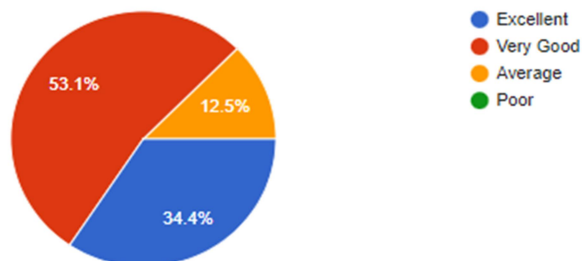

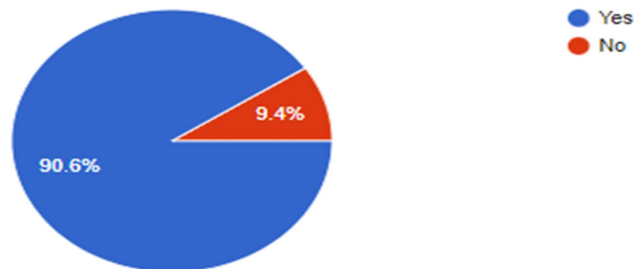
4. Does your ward regularly inform you about his/her academic performance ?

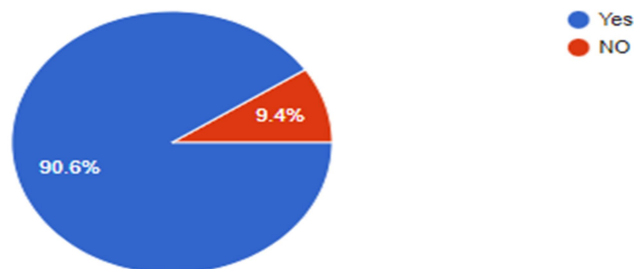
5. Are you aware about your ward's attendance in college ?

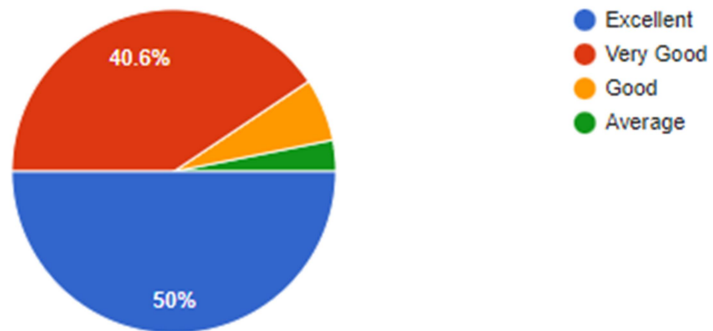

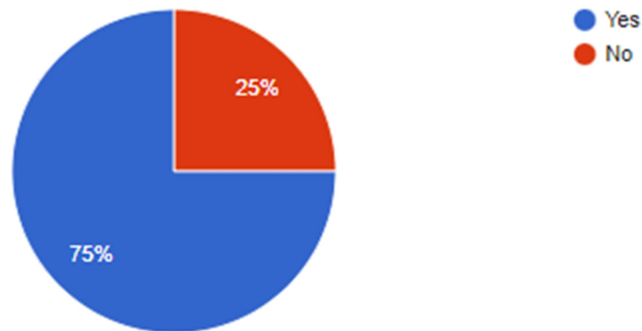
7. Teaching standard at ACE and teacher's approach toward student.

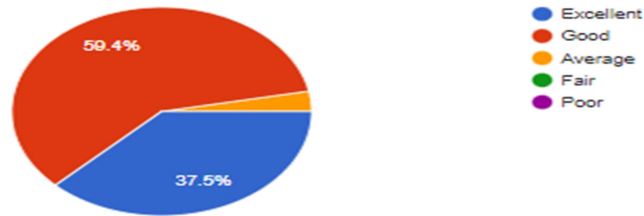

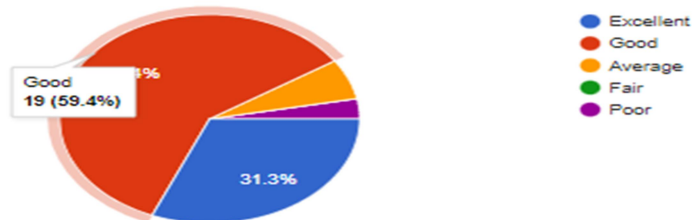

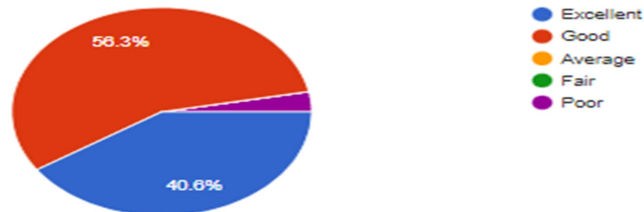
12. Is the syllabus compatible with the industry standards & applicable/relevant to real life situations?

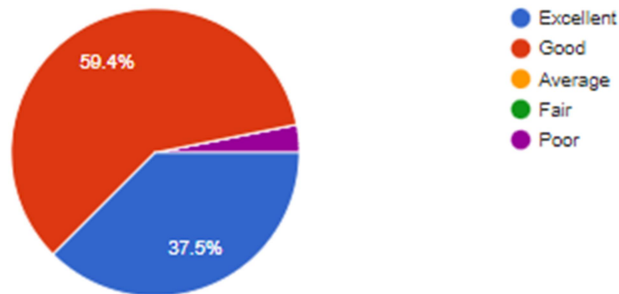

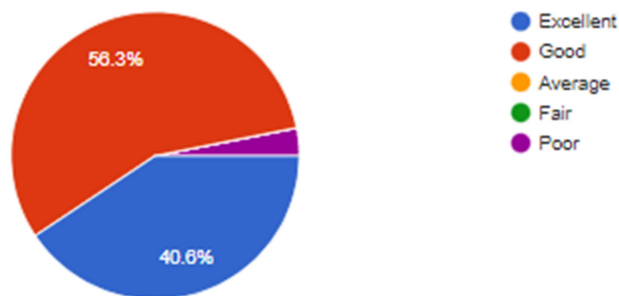

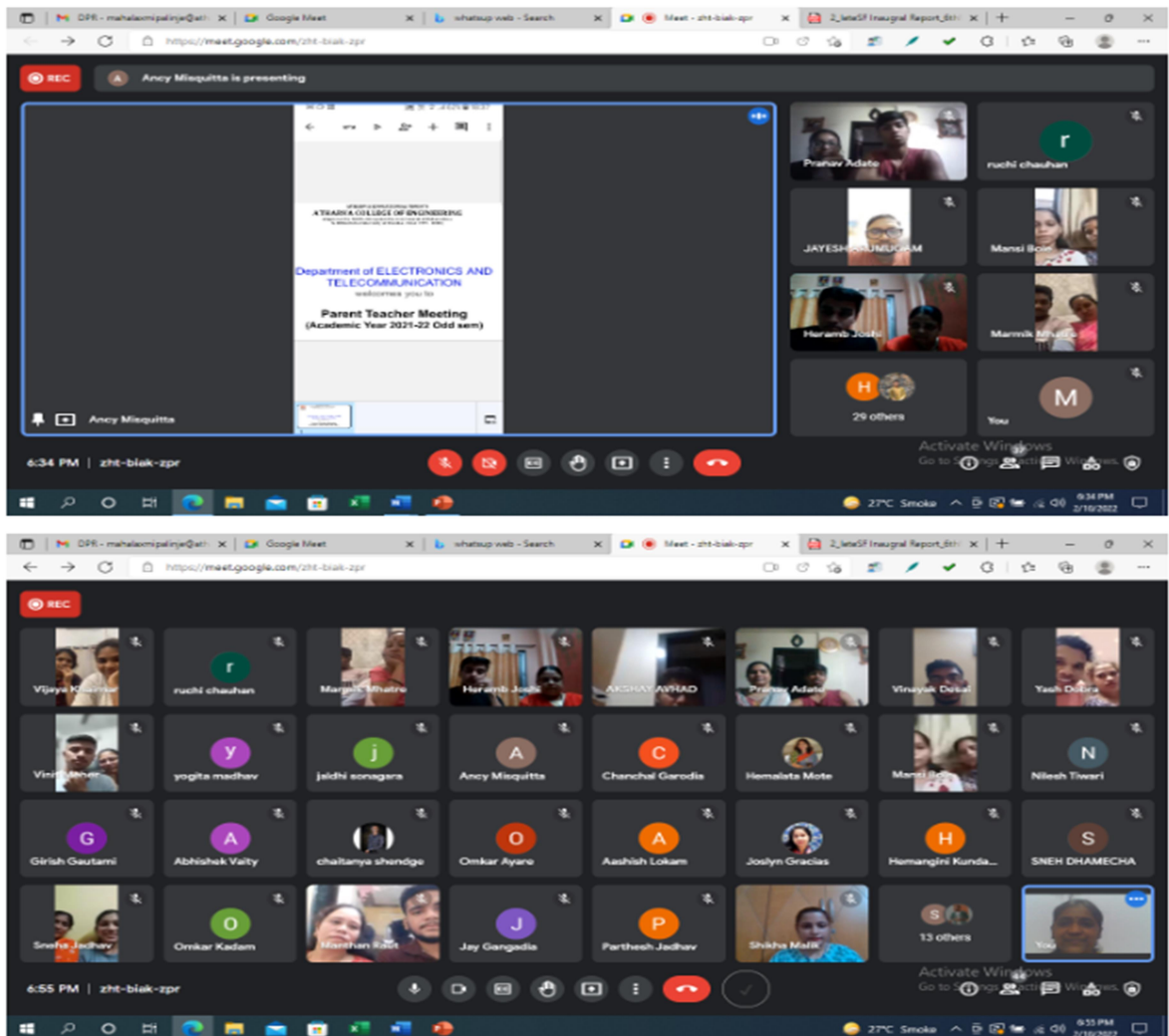
