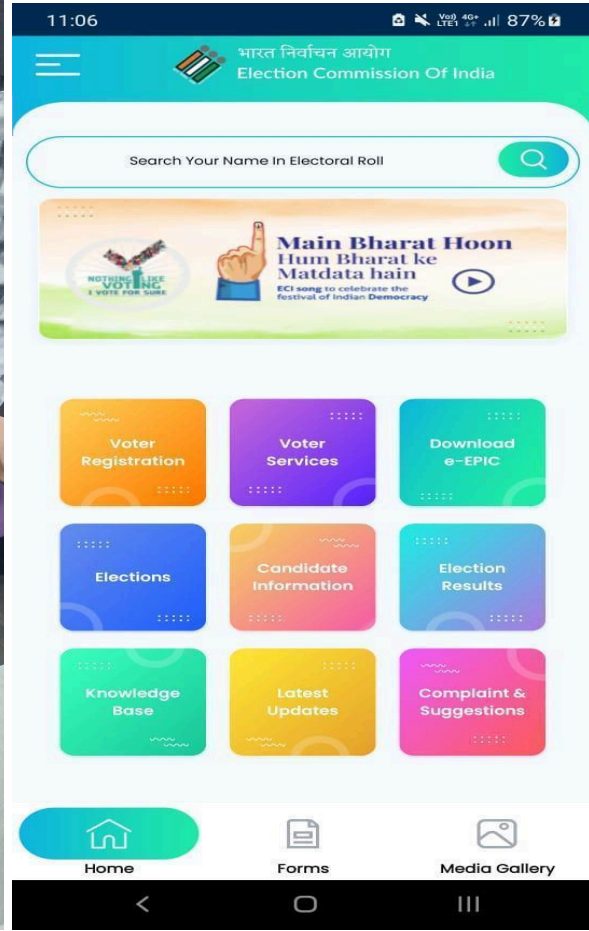
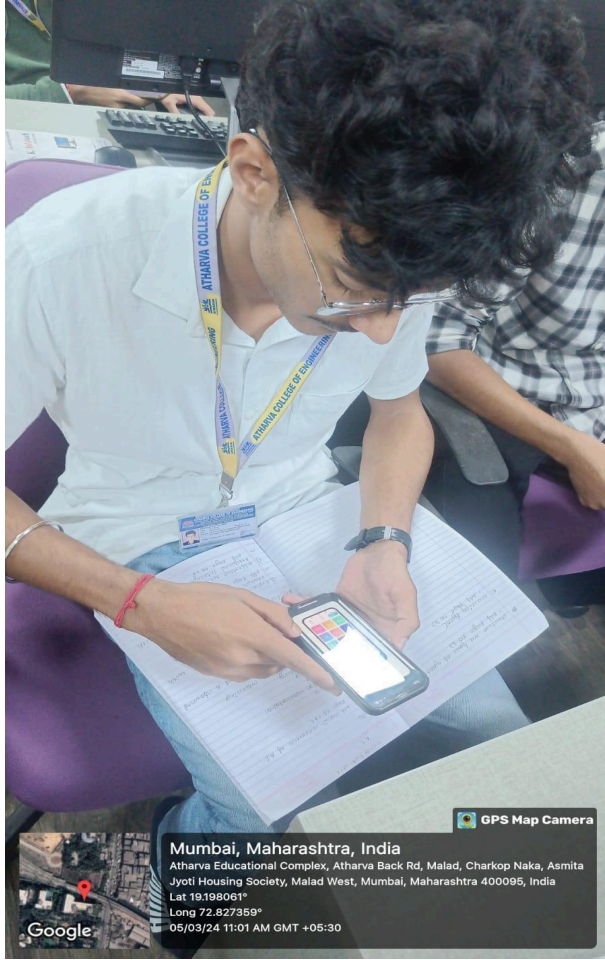
The Voter Helpline App offers the ability to store a digital copy of your voter card and utilize it to enter polling places with a Voter Wallet.

Report

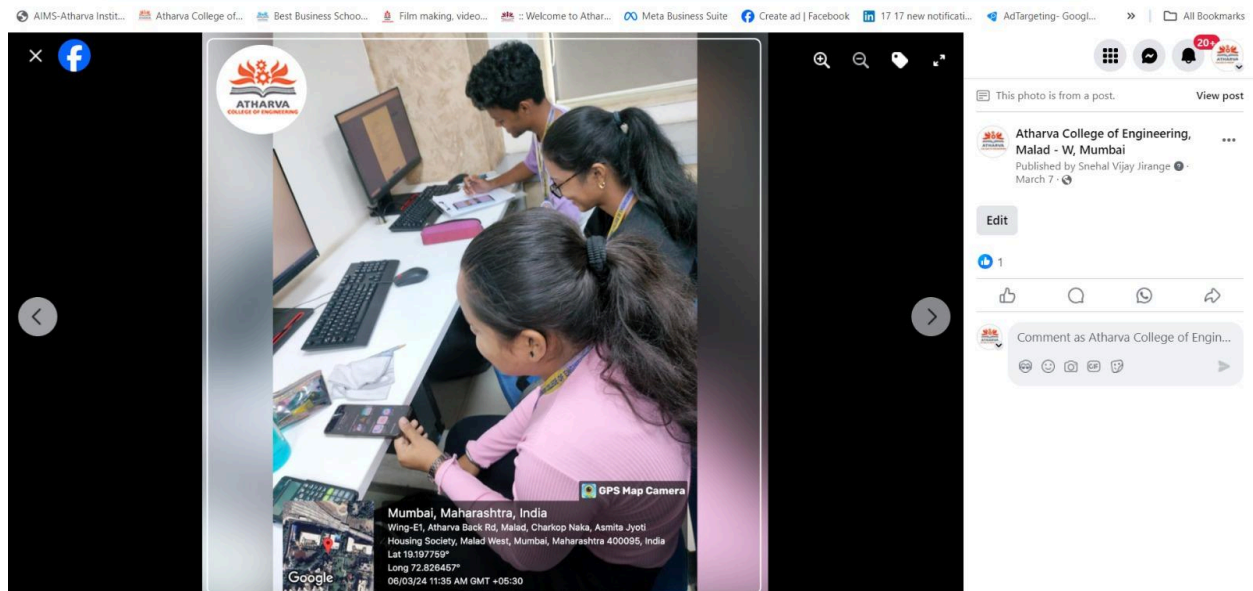
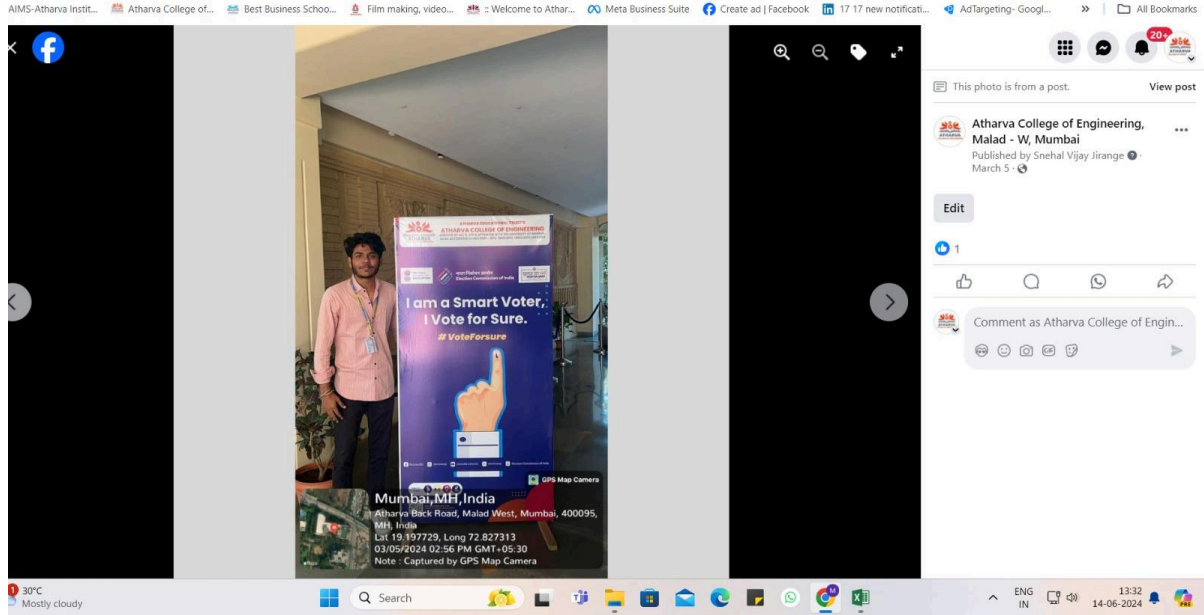

Students understood the importance of casting their votes in order to choose leaders thoroughly with great care and contribute significantly to the advancement of individuals and society.

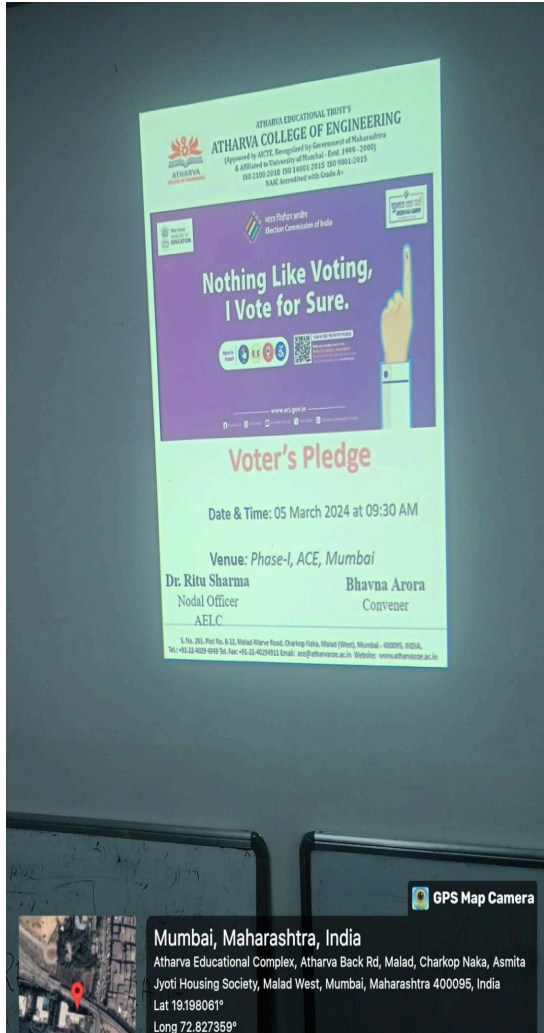
