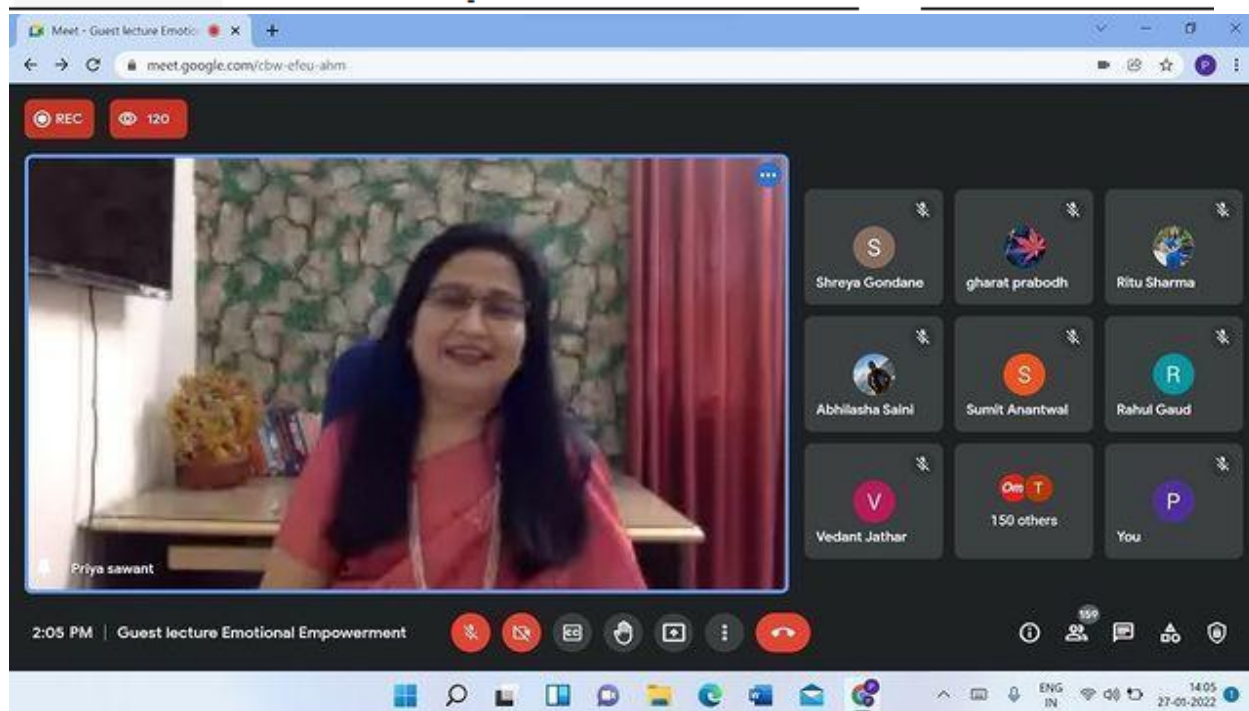
Date: 27/01/2022 18. Emotional Empowerment Guest Lecture
