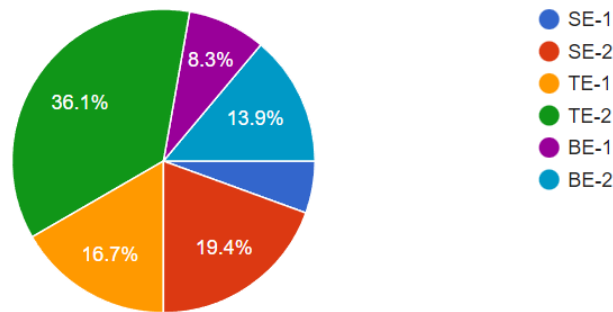

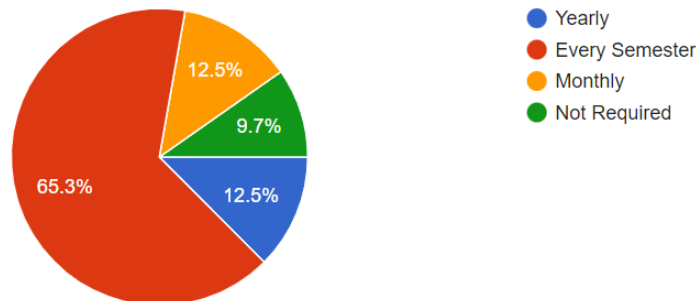

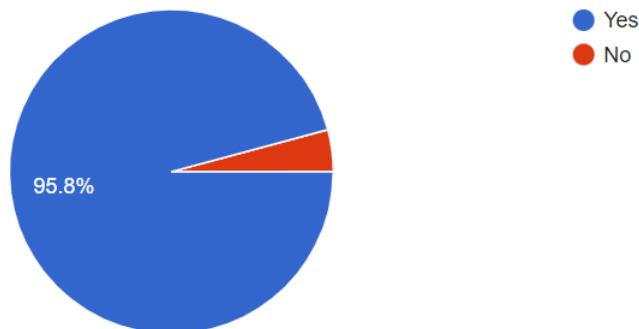
3. Academic Progress of your ward at ACE.

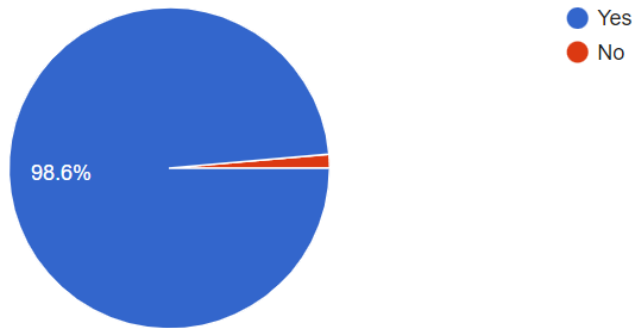

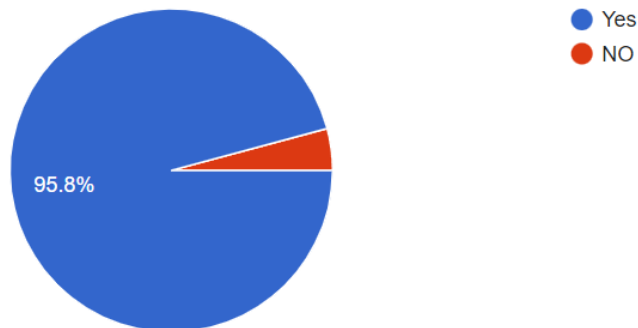
5. Are you aware about your ward's attendance in college ?

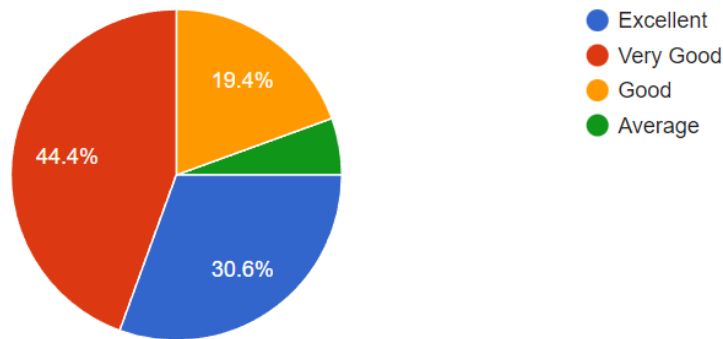

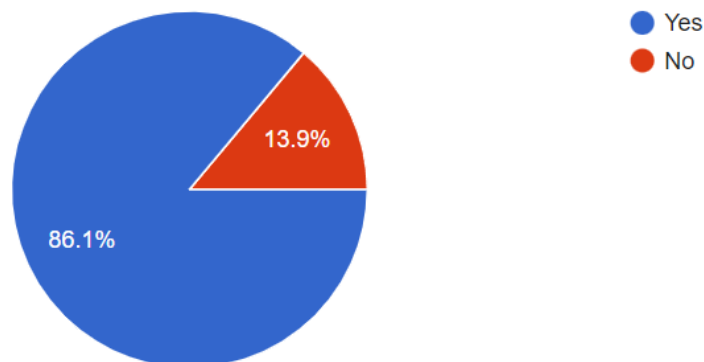
7. Teaching standard at ACE and teacher's approach toward student.

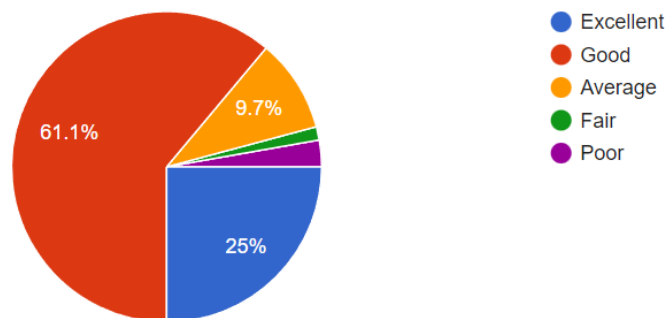

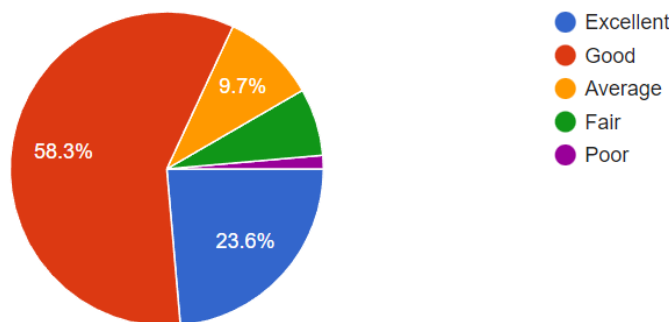
11. Is the syllabus capable of adding Learning values (in terms of skills, concepts, knowledge, analytical abilities or broadening perspectives) in your ward?

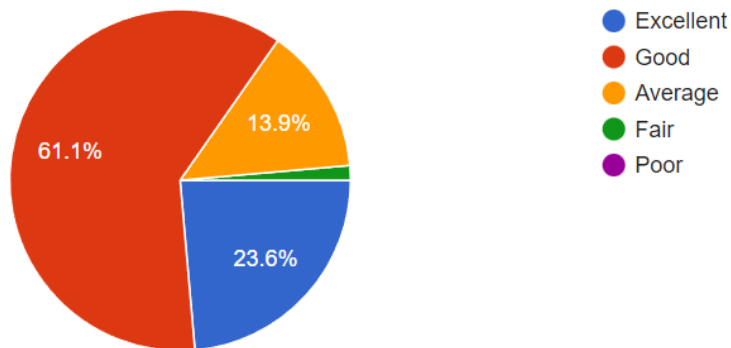
